THE BLESSINGS AND JOY OF THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST BE WITH ALL OF YOU!

The darkness of the tomb, the fear of the disciples behind locked doors gave way to the light of the resurrected body

of Jesus and his words of comfort to his disciples, "Peace be with you. Do not be afraid." How easy it is for us to remain in the darkness and fear of this pandemic, but on this glorious Easter Day, we take to heart the words of St. Paul in his Letter to the Romans, "What can separate us from the love of Christ? Will anguish or distress or persecution or peril? For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor present things, nor future things...nor any other creature will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

We invite into our hearts, into our families, our Risen Lord Jesus, who is our hope, our life, our peace, to dispel our discouragement, our loneliness, our frustration. We pray that just as Christ destroyed the chains of death that held Him bound, he will also destroy the chains of this coronavirus that is the source of so much fear, illness and separation. We take comfort in the beauty of the Easter Kontakion of the Byzantine Liturgy, "You being God arose from the grave, raising the world with you. Mankind praises you as God. Death reigns no more. Adam sings in exultation, O Lord; Eve, freed from bondage, cries joyfully, "O Christ, it is you who give resurrection to all."

"QUEEN OF HEAVEN, REJOICE, ALLELUIA. FOR THE SON WHOM YOU MERITED TO BEAR, ALLELUIA, HAS RISEN AS HE SAID. ALLELUIA."

With Mary, the Mother of our Lord, we rejoice in the Resurrection of our Savior, Jesus Christ and sing her praises of joy. Next Sunday, immediately after the 10:00 a.m. live-streamed Mass, we will pray the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary, followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY is next Sunday, April 18th. Join together to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy in your own homes for Christ's mercy on us and on the whole world, that we may be set free from the evil of this pandemic, and comforted by his compassion and saving grace. PLENARY INDULGENCES. The Apostolic Penitentiary has issued a decree granting plenary indulgences to "the faithful suffering from the Covid-19 virus, as well as to health care workers, family members, and all those who in any capacity including through prayer, care for them." Those who during this pandemic pray for it to end, pray for those who are suffering, and pray for those whom the Lord has called to Himself, are offered a plenary indulgence.

The following conditions apply: the faithful, with a spirit detached from any sins, unite spiritually, to one of the following:

Celebration of Holy Mass (through the media)

Recitation of the Holy Rosary

Recite the Way of the Cross or other forms of devotion

Recite the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Read & pray the Holy Scriptures for at least half an hour

Recite the Creed, the Lord's Prayer and a pious invocation of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The faithful should also have the will to fulfill the usual conditions of sacramental Confession, reception of Holy Communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father, as soon as it is possible.
