

## DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

**April 19, 2020**

**TODAY IS DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY.** This Second Sunday in the Octave of Easter is also called Thomas Sunday, because of the Gospel reading of the apostle Thomas' profession of faith, "My Lord, and my God." Today we lift up with faith ourselves, our families, our parish and the world to the Divine Mercy of Christ Jesus crucified, Christ Jesus, risen from the dead. We encourage you to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy for the healing of our world. We will bless everyone today with the relic of St. Faustina Kowalska, who received the private revelation of Christ, calling us to give honor to His great love, forgiveness and mercy by praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet.

**THIS IS THE DAY THE LORD HAS MADE; LET US REJOICE AND BE GLAD!** Lent, Holy Week and Easter 2020 will long be remembered as a time of profound sadness and great joy, as well as a time of limitations and creative innovativeness. We had a first hand experience this year of what it must have been like for Mary Magdalene and the disciples of the Lord to peer into the empty tomb, as we celebrated Easter liturgies in empty churches. I am most grateful for the technological savvy of our parishioners Nevio Prosen, Zac Bruner and Marty Marsic for putting into motion the ability to live-stream our Holy Week Liturgies, which could then be watched on St. Mary's Facebook page (we will continue to live-stream on Sundays at 10:00 a.m. until we can once again gather together in church). We have so many people to thank for continuing a sense of normalcy in these difficult times of the pandemic. While keeping safe social distance, a few of our choir members and organist, Ed Ferrazzoli, were able to lift us up spiritually as they provided music for all of our liturgies. Our masked bell ringers greeted Easter Sunday morning with the special ringing of the church bells. As one of them commented, "It wouldn't be Easter without the bells." We decorated the church to reflect our festive spirit even in spite of our limitations so at least those who were watching our celebrations online and those who came to pray privately could enjoy the beauty of our church. Besides, we already had the Easter flowers ordered and it would have been terribly unfair to the growers to cancel our order. It is truly amazing to see how many people have made the effort to reach out and stay connected with our homebound parishioners to make sure they are safe and not forgotten. My special gratitude for your cards and words of support, for the Easter gifts and candy (yes, I even got packages of Easter "peeps"). Easter this year was quite different, but pandemic or not, it is and will always be the day the Lord has made for us, and because of our faith, we continue to rejoice. As Pope Francis commented, we have to let the "contagion of hope" replace our fear and pray for a speedy return to normalcy in our lives. May the glory of the risen Christ fill our hearts with peace, steadfastness of faith, and tremendous hope throughout this Easter season.
