SHEPHERD. The Fourth Sunday of Easter is often called Good Shepherd Sunday because the Gospel of the day is the story of

Jesus, the Good Shepherd. May we pray that all those that God has called to shepherd his Church may be filled with courage, zeal, devotion and love for the sheep of God's flock.

TODAY IS THE 57TH WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS.

In his message to the world, Pope Francis centered on four key words: pain, gratitude, encouragement and praise as he reflected on the gospel passage of Jesus calming the storm. Whether our call, our vocation is to married life, the single life, religious life or the priesthood, there is always risk. It means facing the storms of life, the difficulty, the doubt, the fear. But no matter how challenging our vocation may be, we must always keep our eyes focused on the One who calls us, on our Lord Jesus. We must always have a sense of gratitude that Jesus calls us; that He trusts in us to carry on his mission. He knows life can be tough; life can even be dangerous, but he is always at our side with his words of encouragement, "Take heart, it is. Do not be afraid." If we center only on the difficulties of our vocations, the responsibilities that await us, it's very easy to give up and turn our gaze away from Jesus. But we are called to serve the Lord with gladness. We are called to put our hand into his hand, to find our hope and our joy in God our Savior. No matter what our vocation may be, Jesus must be the rock on which we build our lives of service to Him and to God's people. As Pope Francis says, "May the Church touch the hearts of the faithful and enable each person to discover with gratitude God's call, to find courage to say "yes" to God, to overcome all weariness through faith in Christ, and to make of their lives a song of praise for God, for their brothers and sisters, and the whole world. May the Virgin Mary accompany us and intercede for us."

DID YOU KNOW THAT THE FEAST OF ST. FLORIAN IS MAY 4TH? Florian was an officer of the Roman army in Noricum (present-day Austria). During the persecution of Christians under the Emperor Diocletian, he surrendered to the troops of the governor Aquilinus in Lorch. He was twice scourged, half-flayed alive and finally thrown into the River Enns with a huge stone tied around his neck in 304 A.D. His body was recovered by a pious woman and was eventually buried in the Augustinian Abbey of St. Florian in Linz, Austria. He is venerated as a protector from fire or water, and is thus the patron saint of firefighters. Throughout Central Europe (including Austria and Slovenia), you will often see a painting of St. Florian on the exterior wall of the firehouse, pouring water over a burning building.



DANES JE 57. SVETOVNI DAN MOLITVE ZA POKLICE. V njegovem sporočilu svetu je papež Frančišek osredotočil na štiri besede: bolečina, hvaležnost, spodbuda in slava, ko on razmišlja Evangelijev odlomek o Jezusu, ki pomiri nevihto. Bodisi, da je naš poklic v zakonsko življenje, samsko življenje redovno ali duhovno življenje je vedno tvegano. To pomeni soočenje z nevihtami življenja, težavami, dvomi in strahom. Ne glede kako izzivalen je naš poklic mi moramo držati naše oči obrnjene na Njega, ki nas kliče, na našega Gospoda Jezusa. Mi moramo vedno imeti občutek hvaležnosti, da nas Jezus kliče, ker On zaupa v nas, da bomo nosili naprej njegovo poslanstvo. ALI STE VEDELKI, DA JE GOD SV. FLORIJANA 4. MAJA? Florijan je bil oficir Rimske armade v Noricum (sedaj Avstrija), Med preganjanjem kristjanov pod cesarjem Dioklecijanom, on se je vdal vojski voditelja Akulinisa v Lorču. Bil je dvakrat bičan in napol– odret iz kože, potem vržen v reko Enns z velikim kamnom privezanem okrog vrata v 304 A.D. Njegovo truplo je našla pobožna žena in je bil končno pokopan v Avguštinski Opatiji Sv. Florijana v Linzu, Avstrija. On je zaščitnik pred ognjem in vodo in je zavetnik gasilcev. V Srednji Evropi (tudi Avstriji in Sloveniji) boste velikokrat videli sliko Sv. Florijana na zunanjih stenah gasilskega doma, ki zliva vodo na gorečo hišo.
