

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT**December 6, 2020**

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION. Even though the obligation to participate at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days has been suspended during the time of the pandemic, it is still fitting and proper to honor Mary, immaculately conceived in the womb of her mother St. Ann, on her feastday, December 8th. This is also the patronal feastday of the United States of America. We will have Vigil Mass on Monday, December 7th at 7:00 p.m. as well as Masses on December 8th at 8:00 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. May we beseech Mary to pray for us as individuals and as a nation and bring us closer to her Son Jesus, the Giver of all Life, especially in defending the rights of the unborn. We pray also that Mary extend her mantle of protection and peace over these United States.

ADVENT EUCHARISTIC ADORATION. Every Thursday during the Holy Advent Season, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 2:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Beginning at 6:15 p.m. we will pray the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary, whose “yes” to God allowed earth to be touched by Heaven in the person of Jesus Christ, followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament as we worship the Presence of Emmanuel — God among us.
