THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME January 24, 2021

FAMILY PERSPECTIVE. Jesus approaches his first disciples, Simon and Andrew, inviting them to leave their fishing nets and turning their attention to catching people in the nets of God's love. Jesus is being a spiritual mentor to Simon and Andrew. The responsorial psalm implores, "teach me your ways, O Lord." How can you be spiritual mentors and guides in your family? What words do you say, what actions do you do to catch and hold members of your family in the nets of God's love?

A WEEK OF LEARNED SAINTS. Beginning today, January 24, we honor St. Francis de Sales (1567-1622), who admitted it took 20 years to overcome his terrible temper that turned him into the "Gentleman Saint", renowned for his kindness and charity as a teacher and as bishop of Geneva. His numerous pamphlets on authentic Catholic teaching had a profound effect on winning many Calvinist Protestants in the city of Geneva back to the Faith. He is especially remembered for his book "On the Devout Life", and is patron of the Catholic Press.

St. Paul was an ardent Pharisee and persecutor of the early Church. But after his conversion he became the Apostle to the Gentiles, preaching and teaching Christ Jesus crucified, Christ Jesus risen from the dead. His style of teaching, sometimes difficult to understand, reflected the rabbinic tradition of his day.

Timothy and Titus, disciples of St. Paul, give us a glimpse in to the everyday difficulties and problems of preaching and teaching the Faith, probably no different than our own times. Beset with correcting errors and abuses in the early Christian communities, it was the love of Christ that sustained them in their daily struggles.

St. Angela Merici (1470-1540) founded the Ursuline Sisters, the first teaching order of women in the Church. Her goal was to re-Christianize family life through the solid Christian education of young women.

St. Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274) is one of the greatest teachers of the Church of the Middle Ages showing the unity and harmony of faith and reason. Although his parents wanted him to be a Benedictine monk, much to their chagrin, he joined the Dominicans. He completed his studies at the universities of Paris and Cologne. We sometimes forget that the great universities of Europe were founded and supported by the Church. Thomas' greatest and last work was the "Summa Theologica". Although uncompleted, it represents a summary of the whole of Catholic theology. In his own words he said, "I cannot go on. All that I have written seems like so much straw compared to what I have seen and what has been revealed to me."

DRUŽINSKA PERSPEKTIVA. Jezus se približa svojim prvim učencem Simonu in Andreju, povabi jih naj pustita ribiške mreže in obrne njihovo pozornost, loviti ljudi v mreže Božje ljubezni. Jezus je bil duhovni mentor Simonu in Andreju. Odpev psalma roti, "Svoja pota, Gospod mi pokaži." Kako bi lahko vi bili duhovni mentorji in voditelji v vaši družini? Katere besede bi rekli, kako bi delovali, da bi lovili in držali člane vaše družine v mreži Božje ljubezni?

TEDEN UČENIH SVETNIKOV. Začenši danes 24. januarja, mi častimo Sv. Frančiška Saleškega (1567-1622), ki je priznal, vzelo je 20 let, da je premagal njegov grozen temperament, in njega obrnilo v "gospoda svetnika" uglednega za prijaznost in dobroto, kot učitelja in škofa Geneve. Njegove številne brošure za verodostojno katoliško poučevanje je imelo globok učinek pridobiti veliko Kalvinistih protestantov v Genevi nazaj v pravo vero. On je spomnjen za njegovo knjigo "Na pobožno življenje" in je zavetnik katoliških častnikarjev. Sv. Pavel je bil zagrizen sovražnik zgodnje Cerkve. Toda po njegovem spreobrnenju je postal apostol poganom, pridigal in učil Kristus Jezus križani, Kristus Jezus vstali od mrtvih. Njegov način učenja je bilo včasih nerazumljivo, odražal je rabinščino tradicijo njegovega dne. Timotej in Tit, učenca Sv. Pavla dajeta nam bežen pogled v vsakdanje težave in probleme v pridiganju in učenju vere, verjetno nič drugače kot v današnjem času. Obdani s popravili napak in zlorabo v zgodnjih krščanskih skupnostih je bila ljubezen do Kristusa, da so vztrajali v njihovih vsakdanjih Sv. Angela Merici, (1470-1540) Ustanoviteljica težavah. uršulink, prvi učiteljski red žena v Cerkvi. Njen cilj je bil, da ponovno pokristjani družinsko življenje po trdni krščanski izobrazbi mladih žena. Sv. Tomaž Akvinski, (1225-1274) je eden velikih učiteljev Cerkve v Srednjem veku, kazal je enotnost in ubranost vere in razuma. Čeprav so njegovi starši hoteli, da bi bil Benediktinski redovnik, je na njihovo nejevoljo šel k Dominikancem. On je dovršil njegov študij na univerzah v Parizu in Cologne. Včasih pozabimo, da velike universe v Evropi so bile ustanovljene in podprte od Cerkve. Tomaževo veliko in zadnje delo je bilo "Summa Teologika" Čeprav nedokončano, to predstavlja povzetek celotne katoliške teologije. V njegovih lastnih besedah je on rekel: "jaz ne morem nadaljevati. Vse kar imam napisano, zgleda kot veliko slame v primerjavi kaj sem videl in kaj je bilo meni razodeto."
