

**FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME****January 31, 2021**

**FAMILY PERSPECTIVE.** In today's first reading, God promises to raise up a prophet to speak his words. Who are our modern-day prophets? The "Church of the Home" calls us to openness to the teaching of Christ. The psalmist reminds us that as we encounter trials and temptations that we should not harden our hearts, but to trust in God's goodness.

**FEBRUARY 2, CANDLEMAS DAY.** Today, 40 days after the celebration of the birth of Jesus our Savior, the Church celebrates the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. As we remember Simeon's prophetic words that Jesus would be a "light to the nations" the true light and life of the world, on this day during 7:45 a.m. Mass, we will bless candles which will be used in the church or in the home.

**FEBRUARY 3, ST. BLAISE DAY.** At the conclusion of the 7:45 a.m. morning Mass, we will bless throats, asking the prayerful intercession of St. Blaise to protect us from all ailments of the throat and from every evil. Because of the COVID pandemic, we will offer the blessing to all in attendance by extending our hands over the people while saying the prayer of blessing. Individual blessings, for those who wish, will be given after Mass.

**PATRIOTIC ROSARY** will be prayed on Wednesday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>, at 6:30 p.m. in the church. The St. Blaise blessing will also be offered after the rosary.

**CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK** begins today, January 31st. While St. Mary's no longer has a day school, we are still committed to Catholic Education through our Parish School of Religion (PSR Program), encouraging parents to be our first educators of their children in the Catholic Faith, and offering opportunities for growth in understanding and experiencing the priority of our faith and moral values in daily life. We encourage our parents to spend some time every week in sharing Catholic Faith with our children, even if only for 10 or 15 minutes. It could be through review of PSR lessons, asking questions about the people of the Bible, discussing importance of prayer, how God has touched your life, and discussing some of the moral dilemmas we face today. Ask your children questions and let them ask you questions. If you don't know or aren't sure of what we teach and believe as Catholic Christians, ask Fr. Kumse, Deacon David or someone else in the know. Every question is a good question.

You will see that we operated in the red this past year because of church project expenses for the floor and pew work and the remaining costs of the church entranceway, as well as less income from the parish fund raisers, fewer donations and less return on some of our investment accounts.

If you feel there are discrepancies, please contact us as soon as possible.
