

**SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME****February 14, 2021**

**FAMILY PERSPECTIVE.** In today's Gospel, we hear how Jesus touches the leper who is considered impure and unclean due to his skin infection. The Gospel story is a story of mercy, acceptance, compassion and empathy. Jesus is "moved with pity" at the plight of the leper. Even though it broke the Jewish law of his time, Jesus reaches out to him and touches him. How as Christians do we treat our family members with mercy and acceptance and compassion? Throughout his life, Jesus seeks out those who are on the margins. How do we respond to those in our family who are on the margins of society or those who are shunned because we consider them unclean and unworthy?

**ASH WEDNESDAY.** This Wednesday, February 17, we begin the holy penitential season of Lent, a time for personal reflection on our relationship with God and with others, a time to return to the Lord with humble and contrite hearts, a time to remember that our bodies are dust and will return to dust, but our souls will come before the presence of God where we will be judged for what we have done and what we have failed to do. Ashes will be distributed during Mass. This year, because of COVID, following the ancient tradition of the Church, ashes will be sprinkled on the head rather than marking the forehead with a cross.

**FAST AND ABSTINENCE.** During Lent, Ash Wednesday and all Fridays are days of abstinence from meat and all meat products, including soups made from meat stock for everyone age 14 and older. Sorry, no senior citizen exceptions!! Meat is considered the flesh of any warm blooded animal, which includes poultry. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of strict fast for those 18 years of age to 59 years of age. Fasting means only one regular meal during the day, with lessor portions for the other two meals, and no snacking in between meals.

**LENTEN DEVOTIONS.** During Lent we will pray the Stations of the Cross in English on Fridays at 6:30 p.m. and in Slovenian on Sundays at 2:00 p.m., followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. We will also have Eucharist Adoration on Thursdays from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. On Fridays of Lent, we will have Mass at 7:00 p.m., following Stations of the Cross. There will be a Holy Hour after Mass concluding with Night Prayer, Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Make an extra Lenten sacrifice and join us in praying these devotions.
