

## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

February 28, 2021

**FAMILY PERSPECTIVE.** The Transfiguration takes place only a few days after Jesus discloses to his disciples the suffering and death he must endure, telling them, “The Son of Man must suffer greatly and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and rise after three days.” The disciples had to question what rising from the dead meant and listen to Jesus. How do you take time in prayer not only to talk as a family, but to listen to one another and to Jesus?

**YEAR OF ST JOSEPH.** On December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021, Pope Francis declared the year of St. Joseph. This coincided with the 150th anniversary of the proclamation of St. Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX in 1870. Pope Francis also published his Apostolic Letter about St. Joseph “*Patris Corde*” or “With a Father’s Loving Heart.” Since March is the month of St. Joseph, it is a good time to reflect on the spiritual importance of St. Joseph, an often times forgotten saint. Pope Francis calls St. Joseph the “ordinary” saint. While we know little about the life of Joseph from the Bible, we do know much about his virtues from his actions. As foster father of Jesus and husband of Mary, he stands as an example for husbands and fathers. He was a father of sacrifice, hard work, a man of responsibility, who was content to remain in the background. He was a man of patience and humility, who faced the uncertainties of life with courage and trust. He was a man of obedience to the will of God, even when he didn’t understand. As a husband and father, Joseph was tender and loving, who always put his family first. He had a normal job as a carpenter, and was a just and God-fearing man.

Especially in this Year of St. Joseph, as we honor him on his feastday, March 19th, we especially invite the men of our parish to recommit themselves to their families, to pray for them and with them in the spirit of St. Joseph. We as the faithful pray for all fathers, and especially new fathers, that they may emulate the virtues of St. Joseph in their family life. Our world needs good, strong, faithful and prayerful fathers. Pray also for the protection of the Church under the patronage of St. Joseph. Learn more about this ordinary, yet remarkable saint by praying the Litany of St. Joseph, the Quiet Man, who speaks eloquently to us with his silence.

**PARISH COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY.** Council met on Tuesday, February 16th after the 50/50 Raffle drawing. Discussion centered on the effects of the pandemic on the life of the parish, especially the opportunities for social gatherings and the loss of revenue from cancelled fund raisers. At this time, we are not planning on Lenten Fish Fries, but if the number of COVID cases continues to fall and the possibility of getting closer to herd immunity becomes reality in late March, as is being discussed, there is a possibility that we may have a few fish fries toward the end of Lent or in April. We want a safe environment for both workers and diners. We are planning to have our parish summer picnic which will be on Sunday, August 15th. The owner of the house at 701 E. 155th. St. approached the parish about purchasing the property. We expressed our interest and are working with the diocese to move this forward. The issue of the church floor was again brought up. We want to get a few more estimates before making a commitment about doing the work and how and when the work will be done. Deacon David will get information from the Seminary about the company that did their lobby and library. Next meeting will be March 9th.
