FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY. There are two dogmas of Christianity that mark us members of the Church. The first is the dogma of the Holy Trinity-that there is one Triune God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, equal yet distinct Persons of the one Godhead. The second dogma is the Incarnation, that the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity, Jesus, is truly Son of God and Son of Man, having both a divine nature and a human nature. To deny these two dogmas, would put us outside of the Christian faith.

Today we reaffirm our belief in the Most Holy Trinity, which is something we do at every Sunday Liturgy as we make our Profession of Faith as stated in the Nicene Creed. We acknowledge that God the Father is the Creator, God the Son is the Redeemer, and that the Holy Spirit is the Sanctifier. When we pray, we usually begin with the Sign of the Cross, blessing ourselves with the sign of our salvation, in the Name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Why? Because we believe that all prayer is addressed to the Father, in the Name of Jesus the Son, in the power and love of the Holy Spirit.

WE REMEMBER. Monday, May 31st is not only the Feast of the Visitation of Mary to her relative Elizabeth, but also Memorial Day in the United States. Traditionally called Decoration Day, it was a day to remember and decorate the graves of Civil War soldiers. It was later expanded to remember all who made the ultimate sacrifice in time of war defending the freedom we enjoy in this nation. It has now become a day to remember all of our beloved dead with visits to the cemetery, placing flowers on the graves and offering prayers. "Eternal memory grant unto them, O Lord."

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION. Next Sunday on the Solemnity of the Body & Blood of Christ, we will have our annual procession. We kindly ask those with Slovenian national dress (narodna noša) to join us in procession. We also ask our Altar Society members to please bring flowers for the altars and help with flower arrangements. We are also in need of some volunteers early Sunday morning to help set up the altars, preferably before or immediately after the 8:00 a.m. Mass. If you could help, please contact Fr. Kumse.

MASS INTENTIONS FOR 2022. We will begin taking Mass intentions for next year on Tuesday, June 15th. Remember that we can only take two intentions per family at this time: one for a weekend Mass and one for a weekday Mass. You are more than welcome to combine names for your Masses.

NO MORE DISPENSATION FROM SUNDAY MASS AND HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION. The Catholic Bishops of Ohio have announced that the weekend of June 5th and June 6th the dispensation from attending Mass (except for those who are ill, have significant health risk factors or care for someone who is immune-compromised or ill) is hereby rescinded. This day's Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is an appropriate day for all Catholics to return to the Eucharist.

POST PANDEMIC GUIDELINES FOR THE DIOCESE OF CLEVELAND OFFERED BY BISHOP MALESIC AS OF JUNE 2, 2021.

- * Face masks are no longer required, but are strongly suggested for those that have not yet received the COVID-19 vaccine or are otherwise vulnerable.
- * Social distancing is no longer required. The use of all pews is permitted.
- * Holy Water should be replaced in the holy water fonts.
- * Liturgical Processions at the beginning and conclusion of the liturgy, as well as offertory procession are permitted.
- * The sign of peace among the faithful is permitted. It should be exchanged without physical contact between persons who are not from the same family.
- * All Liturgical ministers are permitted (altar servers, lectors, musicians, choirs, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.)
- * Holy Communion: distribution of the Precious Blood of Christ is still suspended. It is still recommended that a person receive Holy Communion in the hand, but the right to receive on the tongue remains. We still ask that those receiving on the tongue receive last.
- * Greeting the faithful: Clergy may greet parishioners after Mass.
- * Hymnals and other books may be returned to the pews.
- * Cleaning of Church: a general cleaning should take place on a regular schedule, with special attention given to frequently used surfaces, such as bathroom fixtures & door handles.
- * Hand sanitizers should continue to be provided at the church entrances.
- * Live streaming Masses should continue when possible.
- * Visitation to the homebound is again permitted.
- * Care should be taken to continue following CDC, state and local guidelines with regard to activities with children who have not yet been fully vaccinated.
- * Continue to pray for a complete end to the pandemic, for all those who died from the pandemic and for those who have lost loved ones, or those whose employment has been adversely impacted.
