(CORPUS CHRISTI)**

June 6, 2021

CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY. Today we give due honor and glory to the Eucharistic Presence of Jesus Christ. From the Last Supper and the beginnings of Christianity, it is the Holy Eucharist which is the source and summit of our life. It is the Presence of Jesus that demands our devotion, love and respect. Today, during our procession around the church, we stop at each of the four altars and pray for God's protection and blessings upon the parish, our neighborhood and our city, so that from east to west, north to south, the power and presence of Christ may be praised and glorified.

"By a word the Word embodied changes common bread and wine. Bread becomes his holy Body, wine is made his Blood Divine. Though this truth evades the senses, faith unveils the sacred sign.

Humbly let us voice our homage for so great a Sacrament. Let all former rites surrender to the Lord's new Testament. What our senses fail to fathom, let us grasp through faith's consent."

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS. Every year, 19 days after Pentecost, this year, Friday, June 11th, the Church honors the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The open heart of our Lord reveals to us God's boundless and passionate love for his people. Great devotion to the Sacred Heart grew after the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alaquoque, but the first celebration in honor of the Sacred Heart actually took place on August 31, 1670 in Rennes, France, with St. John Eudes composing the orations for the Feast Day Mass. Those who honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus will have peace in their families, greater holiness and perfection in life, and comfort in their trials. Lukewarm souls will find their faith strengthened and all who honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus will have their name written in his Heart forever. May we come to the open Heart of Jesus with trust and confidence and find in Him our strength and our life, and a never ending source of grace and charity.

MEMORIAL OF THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY. The Heart of Mary was filled with the joys and sorrows of being the Mother of our Lord Jesus. When Joseph and Mary presented Jesus in the Temple of Jerusalem, Simeon the prophet told Mary that her heart would be pierced with a sword. As we honor the Immaculate Heart of Mary the day after the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, may we find in her heart the loving devotion of a Mother who shares in our joy and comforts us in our struggles and teaches us to proclaim the greatness of the Lord and to rejoice in God our Savior.

END OF DISPENSATION FOR SUNDAY AND HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION MASSES. The Bishops Conference of Ohio has rescinded the dispensation from attending Mass to all faithful Catholics of the State of Ohio beginning this weekend, June 5th and 6th. This means that all Catholics once again have the opportunity and obligation to gather for Mass and receive the sacrament of Holy Communion if properly disposed. The only exceptions are for those with serious health issues or those who care for the sick or those who are immune compromised.

MASS INTENTIONS FOR 2022. We will begin taking Mass intentions for next year on Tuesday, June 15th. Please remember that we can only take two intentions per family at this time: one for a weekend Mass and one for a weekday Mass. You are more than welcome to combine names for your Masses. In all likelihood, we will only have 2 Sunday Masses in 2022, and one of those Masses must be for the People of the Parish.
