

OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

November 21, 2021

THE SOLEMNITY OF CHIRST THE KING. On this last Sunday of the Church's Liturgical year, we honor Jesus Christ as the Supreme and Universal King of all Creation. This is a relatively new feast, instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925. After World War I there was a rise in secularism which led to a decline in the importance of faith in daily living. Atheism and dictatorships flourished even among Catholic people. People increasingly doubted the existence of Christ and the teaching authority of the Church. (Not much different than our own generation.) Today's feast is a reminder that Christ has all authority and power and wisdom and strength, and that all tribes and nations and people must serve Him.

On November 23, 1927, a Mexican Jesuit, Miguel Pro was martyred for his Faith. The fiercely anti-Catholic government of Mexico at that time tried to eradicate Catholicism. After blessing his executioners, praying for their forgiveness and declaring his innocence, with a crucifix in one hand and a rosary in the other, Miguel Pro faced the firing squad without a blindfold. Before the fatal shots, he extended his arms in imitation of Jesus on the cross and cried out "Viva Cristo Rey-Long Live Christ the King!" As a deterrent to supporters of the Church, the atheistic President of Mexico had Miguel Pro's execution meticulously photographed, with pictures in the daily newspapers. It had the opposite effect. It invigorated the people to continue the fight for justice, liberty and religious freedom. 40,000 people lined the streets for Fr. Pro's funeral procession with another 20,000 who waited for his body at the cemetery. From the crowd came cries of "Long live the martyrs! Long live our Catholic Faith! Long live our bishops and priests! Long live Christ the King!" His own father had the funeral prayers since no priest was permitted to officiate at his funeral.

FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT. Next Sunday, November 28th, we begin the Church's new Liturgical Year and Cycle "C" for Sunday readings. In a few short weeks we will be celebrating the birth of our Lord Jesus. May we prepare well for Christmas, especially through the reception of the Sacrament of Confession.

COLLINWOOD CLUSTER ADVENT VESPER SERVICE. St. Jerome Parish, 15000 Lake Shore Blvd. will once again host the Collinwood parishes on the first Monday of Advent, November 29th at 7:00 p.m. for Evening Prayer and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the altar for adoration, private prayer and meditation immediately after the 7:45 a.m. Mass and throughout the day. The Closing Solemn Vesper Service will be at 4:30 p.m. followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. EVHARISTIČNI DAN. Namesto naših običajnih evharističnih pobožnostih bomo v sredo, 24. novembra, dan pred Zahvalnim dnevom, kot župnika počastili Jezusa v presvetem zakramantu. Najsvetejši bo izpostavljen za češčenje, zasebno molitev in meditacijo takoj po maši ob 7:45 zjutraj in ves dan. Zaključne slovesne večernice in blagoslov z Najsvetejšim bo ob 4:30. Pridružite se nam kot župnijska skupnost, da se to sredo zahvalimo Vsemogočnemu Bogu za njegove številne blagoslove kot župnika in posameznike.

ADVENTNE VEČERNICE COLLINWOODSKIH ŽUPNIJ. Župnija sv. Hieronima, 15000 Lake Shore Blvd. bo na prvi adventni ponedeljek, 29. novembra ob 7.00 zvečer, ponovno gostila Collinwoodske župnije za večernice in blagoslov Najsvetnjega. To bo našo prvo srečanje od začetka pandemije.

DANES JE PRAZNIK KRISTUSA KRALJA

PRAZNIK KRISTUSA KRALJA. Na to zadnjo nedeljo Cerkvenega liturgičnega leta, mi častimo Jezusa Kristusa kot najvišjega in vesoljnega Kralja vsega stvarstva. To je relativno novi praznik, ustanovljen od papeža Pija XI v letu 1925. Po prvi svetovni vojni je prišlo do porasta sekularizma, kar je povzročilo upad pomena vere v vsakdanjem življenju. Ateizem in diktatura je napredovalo celo med katoličani. Ljudje so vedno bolj dvomili v obstoj Kristusa in oblast nauka Cerkve. (Ne veliko razlike od naše lastne generacije.) Današnji praznik je opomin da ima Kristus vso oblast in moč in modrost in da mu morajo služiti vsa plemena, narodi in ljudstva.

23. novembra 1927 je bil mehiški jezuit Miguel Pro mučen za svojo vero. Ostro protikatoliška vlada Mehike je v tistem času poskušala izkoreniniti katolicizem. Potem ko je blagoslovil svoje rablje, molil za njihovo odpuščanje, in razglasil svojo nedolžnost, je z križem v eni roki in rožnim vencem v drugi, se je Miguel Pro brez preveze za oči, soočil z strelnim vodom. Pred usodnimi streli je iztegnil roke v posnemanju Jezusa na križu in zavpil: "Viva Cristo Rey – Živi Kristus kralj!" Kot odvračanje podpornikov Cerkve je ateistični predsednik Mehike imel usmrtilje Miguela Pro-a natančno fotografirano s slikami v dnevnih časopisih. Imelo je nasprotni učinek. Ljudstvo je spodbudilo k nadaljevanju boja za pravičnost, svobodo in versko svobodo. 40,000 ljudi se je zvrstilo na ulicah za pogrebno procesijo Fr. Pro-a z drugimi 20,000, ki so na pokopališču čakali na njegovo truplo. Iz množice so se slišali vzklik "Naj živijo mučeniki! Naj živi naša katoliška vera! Naj živijo naši škofje in duhovniki! Naj živi Kristus Kralj!" Njegov oče je imel pogrebne molitve, saj noben duhovnik ni smel opravljati njegovega pogreba.
